

TITLE: RELIEF LOGGER

CODE: 37004

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

This is responsible logging work involving the performance of varied logging tasks or construction and repair tasks on a seasonal basis.

Work involves responsibility for safe and effective logging production or construction and repair of roads, buildings and facilities. Duties include log cutting and bucking, or operating construction equipment and power and hand tools. This position also has the responsibility for making basic logging or construction and repair decisions in accordance with established procedures. This work requires that the employee have good knowledge, skill and ability in logging and construction and repair methods.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED:

Works under the general supervision of the Logging or Construction and Repair Crew Leader.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:

Fells and bucks trees, as assigned, on a seasonal basis.

Operates construction equipment and hand and power tools in road, building and facilities construction, repair and maintenance, as assigned, on a seasonal basis.

Performs work in a safe manner and observes all safety procedures.

Use all tools, equipment and materials responsibly and performs basic inspection and preventive maintenance prior to use.

Performs work of lower classifications, as necessary.

Performs related work as required.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

Good knowledge of the tools, equipment, and methods of tree felling and bucking.

Good knowledge of the tools, equipment, and methods of road and facilities construction, repair and maintenance.

Good knowledge of the work standards and safety procedures in logging and construction and repair.

Good skill in the operation of logging and construction equipment.

Considerable ability to perform logging and construction and repair safely, effectively and efficiently.

Considerable ability to follow oral and written instructions and to learn District procedures.  
Good ability to communicate orally.

Considerable ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with coworkers.

QUALIFICATIONS:

A high school diploma or the equivalent plus two years of logging and construction experience, or an equivalent combination of education and qualifying experience substituting on a year-for-year-basis.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

Must have a valid Commercial Driver's License, sub-classification "B" with airbrake endorsement.
