

TITLE: SWP PLANT EQUIPMENT OPERATOR

CODE: 38207

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

This is responsible equipment operating work involving the driving of rolloff trucks, tractor-trailers and other solid waste plant rolling equipment.

Work involves responsibility for safe movement of equipment and materials using a variety of rolling equipment. Duties include driving rolloff trucks, front loaders, forklifts, trucks, and sweepers. This position also has the responsibility for making routine equipment operating decisions in accordance with established procedures. This work requires that the employee have good knowledge, skill and ability in rolling equipment operation.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED:

Works under the general supervision of the Solid Waste Processing Plant Shift Supervisor or other supervisory personnel.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:

Drives a rolloff truck to move ferrous and residue rolloff containers within the solid waste processing plant facility.

Operates front loaders, forklifts, trucks, and sweepers to move equipment and material. Assists in minor solid waste processing operations, as assigned.

Maintains buildings and grounds. Assists with plant equipment repairs. Picks up and delivers spare parts.

Performs work in a safe manner and observes all safety procedures.

Uses all tools, equipment and materials responsibly and performs basic inspection and preventive maintenance prior to use.

Fills out job or shift report forms, as assigned.

Performs work of lower classifications, as necessary.

Performs related work as required.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

Good knowledge of the tools, equipment, and methods of rolloff truck and related equipment operation.

Good knowledge of the work standards and safety procedures in rolling equipment operation.

Good skill in the operation of rolloff trucks, front loaders and forklifts.

Considerable ability to operate rolling equipment safely, effectively and efficiently.

Considerable ability to follow oral and written instructions and to learn District procedures.
Good ability to communicate orally.

Considerable ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with coworkers.

QUALIFICATIONS:

A high school diploma or the equivalent plus one year of experience in rolling equipment operation and truck driving, or an equivalent combination of education and qualifying experience substituting on a year-for-year basis.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

Must have a valid Commercial Driver's License, Subclassification "A" with Airbrake Endorsement
