

*TITLE: SOLID WASTE PROCESSING PLANT CLEANER

CODE: 38401

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

This is responsible solid waste processing plant laboring work involving the cleaning of the production area and grounds.

Work involves responsibility for the safe performance of cleaning and labor. Duties include cleaning plant processing equipment, rolling stock equipment, building, and grounds. This position also has the responsibility for making standard processing plant cleaning decisions in accordance with established procedures. This work requires that the employee have good knowledge, skill and ability in processing plant cleaning work.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED:

Works under the general supervision of the Solid Waste Processing Plant Shift Supervisor or Crew Leader.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:

Cleans solid waste processing plant and grounds.

May operate bobcats, forklifts, and walk behind vacuums and other related equipment as assigned.

Assists higher level classifications in manual labor, as assigned.

May perform custodial work, as assigned.

Performs work in a safe manner and observes all safety procedures.

Uses all tools, equipment and materials responsibly and performs basic inspection of them prior to use.

Performs related work as required.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

Good knowledge of tools, equipment, and methods of general laboring work.

Some knowledge of the work standards and safety procedures in general laboring work.

Some skill in the use of hand tools and power equipment in solid waste processing plant cleaning.

Good ability to perform solid waste processing plant cleaning work safely, effectively and efficiently.

Good ability to follow oral instructions and to learn District procedures.

Good ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with coworkers.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Completion of the tenth grade plus some experience in custodial work or general laboring work, or an equivalent combination of education and qualifying experience substituting on a year-for-year basis.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

Must have a valid driver's license.
