

TITLE: SOLID WASTE PROCESSING PLANT MAINTAINER

CODE: 38402

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

This is responsible plant maintenance laboring work involving preventive maintenance, mechanical assistance and general labor.

Work involves responsibility for safe performance of maintenance and labor. Duties include maintaining plant equipment and facilities, assisting mechanics and performing general maintenance and labor. This position also has the responsibility for making routine maintenance decisions in accordance with established procedures. This work requires that the employee have good knowledge, skill and ability in general equipment and building maintenance.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED:

Works under the general supervision of the Plants Maintenance Supervisor.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:

Inspects, cleans and lubricates plant equipment and performs preventive maintenance, as assigned.

Assists equipment mechanics with maintenance and repairs on plant equipment and facilities.

Maintains buildings and grounds. Picks up and delivers spare parts and supplies.

Stores equipment and parts with a forklift and other equipment.

Performs work in a safe manner and observes all safety procedures.

Uses all tools, equipment and materials responsibly and performs basic inspection and preventive maintenance prior to use.

Fills out job forms, as assigned.

Performs related work as required.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

Some knowledge of the tools, equipment and facilities maintenance.

Some knowledge of the work standards and safety procedures in equipment and facilities maintenance.

Good skill in the use of the hand tools and power equipment in equipment and facilities maintenance.

Good ability to perform equipment maintenance safely, effectively and efficiently.

Good ability to follow oral instructions and to learn District procedures.

Good ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with coworkers.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Completion of the tenth grade plus some experience in equipment maintenance, or an equivalent combination of education and qualifying experience substituting on a year-for-year basis.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

Must have a valid driver's license.
