

TITLE: ELECTRICIAN 2

CODE: 39305

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

This is very responsible licensed electrician work involving the performance of the full range of electrician work and the oversight of electricians and assistants.

Work involves responsibility for safe and effective maintenance, repair and installation of electrical systems and equipment. Duties include performing the full range of electrician work and overseeing electricians and assistants. This position also has the responsibility for making difficult electrical trade decisions. This work requires that the employee have considerable knowledge, skill and ability in electrician work.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED:

Works under the general supervision of the Plant Maintenance Administrator or Assistant Plant Maintenance Supervisor.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:

Performs the full range of electrician work.

Detects and repairs difficult electrical system problems.

Oversees the work of lower level electricians and assistants to assure conformance with District and trade standards.

Performs work in a safe manner and observes all safety procedures.

Uses all tools, equipment and materials responsibly and performs basic inspection and preventive maintenance prior to use.

Fills out job or shift report forms, as assigned.

Performs work of lower classifications, as necessary.

Responds to emergencies at any time of day or night, as directed. Serves on-call, as assigned.

Performs related work as required.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

Considerable knowledge of the tools, equipment, and methods of electrician work.

Considerable knowledge of the work standards and safety procedures in electrician work.

Considerable skill in the use of the tools and equipment of the electrician trade.

Considerable ability to perform electrician work safely, effectively and efficiently.

Considerable ability to follow oral and written instructions and to learn District procedures.  
Good ability to communicate orally.

Good ability to fill out forms.

Good ability to oversee the work of others.

Considerable ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with coworkers.

QUALIFICATIONS:

A high school or trade school diploma or the equivalent plus six years of electrician experience.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

Must have a valid driver's license.

Must have a valid E-2 Electrician's license.
