



Edgewood Street Sewer Separation Project in Progress!

The Metropolitan District (MDC) has begun construction of the Edgewood Street Sewer Separation Project. The purpose of this project is to separate existing combined sewers and establish new laterals and connections to homes, which will reduce backups, flooding and improve sewer function. We understand the construction may impact your daily activities so keeping YOU informed is an essential component to the success of our work. Please read below for more information:

What are the details of the project?

- Installation of 1,400 linear feet of new 8-inch water mains
- Installation of 2,350 linear feet of new 8-inch mainline sanitary sewers
- Installation of 4,200 linear feet of new 6-inch sanitary laterals
- Modification of basement waste lines to 76 homes
- New mainline storm sewers and catch basins
- Rehabilitation of approximately 2,000 linear feet of existing sewers
- Tree removal and replacement, including sidewalk and curbing replacement as needed
- Curb to curb (full width) street pavement restoration

When will this project be completed?

Estimated completion is fall 2010
